Charter Commitment

1. STEP UP OUR RESPONSE TO GROWING HUMANITARIAN NEEDS AND HELP PEOPLE ADAPT TO THE IMPACTS OF THE CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENTAL CRISES

4. INCREASE OUR CAPACITY TO UNDERSTAND CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENTAL RISKS AND DEVELOP EVIDENCE-BASED SOLUTIONS

Rolled-out of a dedicated thematic area on Climate and Environmental Stewardship.
Developed organisational capacity to identify and address environmental risks through staff training and the establishment of a coordinated network across country offices.
Built staff capacity to implement anticipatory action through targeted training and workshops.
Conducted feasibility studies to support implementation of anticipatory action in Ethiopia, Pakistan and South Sudan against hazards including flooding, drought and heat-wave.

2. MAXIMISE THE ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY OF OUR WORK AND RAPIDLY REDUCE OUR GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

Scaled up the use of renewable energy across 8 country offices.
Initiated the systematic tracking of our emissions using the Humanitarian Carbon Calculator (HCC+).
Expanded waste management practices across NCA country offices, increasing the share of offices diverting non-organic waste.



53% of NCA's Global staff work from offices that are largely or partially powered by solar energy



Emissions from international air travel per staff member have decreased by 32% since 2022.

3. EMBRACE THE LEADERSHIP OF LOCAL ACTORS AND COMMUNITIES

Supported local ownership of environmental risk management by including 53 partner organizations in NEAT+ trainings to identify, assess, and reduce environmental impacts in their programmes.
Facilitated the participation of representatives from a Sudanese partner organization to COP30 in Brasil.

5. WORK COLLABORATIVELY ACROSS THE HUMANITARIAN SECTOR AND BEYOND TO STRENGTHEN CLIMATE AND ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION

Initiated collaboration with local authorities to align with national anticipatory action frameworks.
Enhanced early warning and climate risk response through partnerships with local meteorological agencies.

6. USE OUR INFLUENCE TO MOBILISE URGENT AND MORE AMBITIOUS ACTION AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

Advocated for stronger international climate finance commitments through COP participation, including support to the Loss and Damage Fund.
Pressure on Norway to deliver its fair share of climate finance in a way that doesn't reduce other development aid.
Influenced national policy processes including calls to scale up the Climate Investment Fund and climate adaptation finance.
Contributed to the establishment of a NOK 5 billion green guarantee scheme to mobilise private investment in renewable energy.
