CONTEXT



Disaster displacement is an escalating challenge for cities and municipalities worldwide. Sudden or protracted displacement caused by disasters can strain local infrastructure, disrupt economies, and exacerbate vulnerabilities for both displaced populations and host communities. Local governments are often on the frontline, tasked with addressing these challenges while managing disaster risks and building community resilience.

The Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction emphasizes the importance of integrating disaster displacement into local disaster risk reduction (DRR) strategies. However, many municipalities struggle to adequately incorporate the needs of displaced populations into their planning processes, leading to gaps in service delivery, increased marginalization, and reduced resilience.

To address this gap, the Disaster Displacement Addendum to the City Resilience Scorecard (referred to as the "Scorecard") has been collaboratively developed by NRC, UNDRR, IOM, IDMC, and PDD. The Scorecard is one of the multiple thematic annexes to the Disaster Resilience Scorecard for Cities published by UNDRR and partners in 2017 to support the Making Cities Resilient 2030 (MCR 2030). It empowers local governments to self-assess their capacity to manage disaster displacement, offering a structured approach to integrating displacement considerations into broader DRR policies and plans.

By leveraging this tool, local governments can identify strengths, address gaps, and implement strategies that enhance resilience, reduce the risks of disaster displacement, and better support displaced populations. This webinar will provide an introduction to the Scorecard, and invite participants to discuss how to apply it in their context.
